MY WATCH AS IFAE DIRECTOR (2008-2014) a somewhat personal view

HOW I ENDED UP IN THIS ROLE

- Joined IFAE in 1993, from U. California-Santa Cruz, after two 6-month visits, during which I started up a small group to build the ATLAS Tile Calorimeter.
- 1993-2002: with M. Bosman and Ll. Miralles, and much help from Enrique and R. Pascual:
 - Made, tested Tile Cal prototypes
 - Built 350 m² workshop (w/ 16-ton crane)
 - Built ¼ of TileCal (about 700 tons)
- 2003: joined CDF, thanks to Mario Martínez.
 - (I did very little, but the IFAE group under Mario did well)
- 2007: Enrique and R. Pascual twisted my arm into being the next IFAE director
 - Only later I realized that they had been planning this for some time...

CHALLENGES, COUNTERMEASURES

- The Spanish (and world-wide) financial crisis, from 2008
 - led to to a cut in Catalan base funding (salary money!)
 - and (gradually) to 30-40% cut in Spanish research funding
- Since 2008, the Spanish Treasury **demands returning funds properly spent on research** (a few hundred k€, already)
 - on the basis of small formalities, or without any legal basis
 - ignoring our objections
- (Local: an issue with ICREA, on professors associated with research centers:)
 - Positively resolved, we had two ICREA-Academia awards
- By 2012, GenCat had reversed part of the base funding cuts
 - Finally: 15% less than expected in 2012, and frozen funding until 2017
 - All IFAE salaries FROZEN since 2010 but no one was fired
- Applied for return of TVA, from 2012 onwards (200-300 k€/year)
 - About 90% successful, with court challenges, and long negotiations.

THE POSITIVE SIDE

- Facilities:
 - Conservation of workshops/labs helped by crisis, that nullified plan to destroy/replace our buildings
 - Built a multifunction clean room, for microelectronics and other activities
 - Expansion of mechanical, electronics and experimental facilities
- Agreements with UAB's V-Rector C. Jaime on workshops and space in main building
 - allowed us to survive and expand without a new building
- New ICREA positions: 2 experimenters, 2 theorists
- Research lines:
 - My initiative:
 - ATLAS Pixels, new
 - Medipix, revived
 - No merit of director: CTA was established in Spain, and internationally
 - No merit of director: expansion of observational cosmology activities, including a whole home-built camera (PAU)





IN RETROSPECT

- In 2007, IFAE had **103** persons (of which **14** in technical division)
- At end of 2014, it had 142 (of which 26 in technical division)
 - In spite of the crisis, and the cuts, we managed some growth
 - Especially of the technical staff.
- A word about style: I am not as discreet as Enrique... and in my watch, the Generalitat made it clear that directors of Catalan research centers have much autonomy, and total responsibility.
 - I liked this message
 - But I felt the need to discuss decisions with R. Miquel, who served for > 6 years as the adjunct director. I am very grateful for his help.
 - I like to be in command. A colleague told me, recently: "You were not a director, you were an emperor".
- I resigned at the end of 2014, with one more year to go as director
 - to let the next director take long-term commitments with research personnel
 - and to return to research, before retiring.

LAST, THE BEST NEWS OF MY WATCH:

- Thanks to Manel Martínez, and with Ramon's help, IFAE in 2012 got the Severo Ochoa excellence award
 - Crucial help against losses of funding
 - Allowed to hire badly needed personnel (KTT, project assistance, communication)
 - Strengthened microelectronics facilities
 - Provided extra student, postdoc positions
 - Helped projects in need
- Renewed in 2016 (more from Manel)
